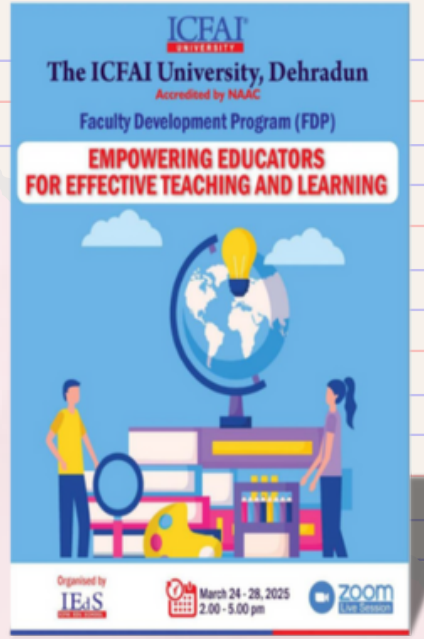
Conclusion

The Yukti Club remains committed to organizing such philanthropic activities in the future, fostering a culture of kindness and social responsibility within the university community.

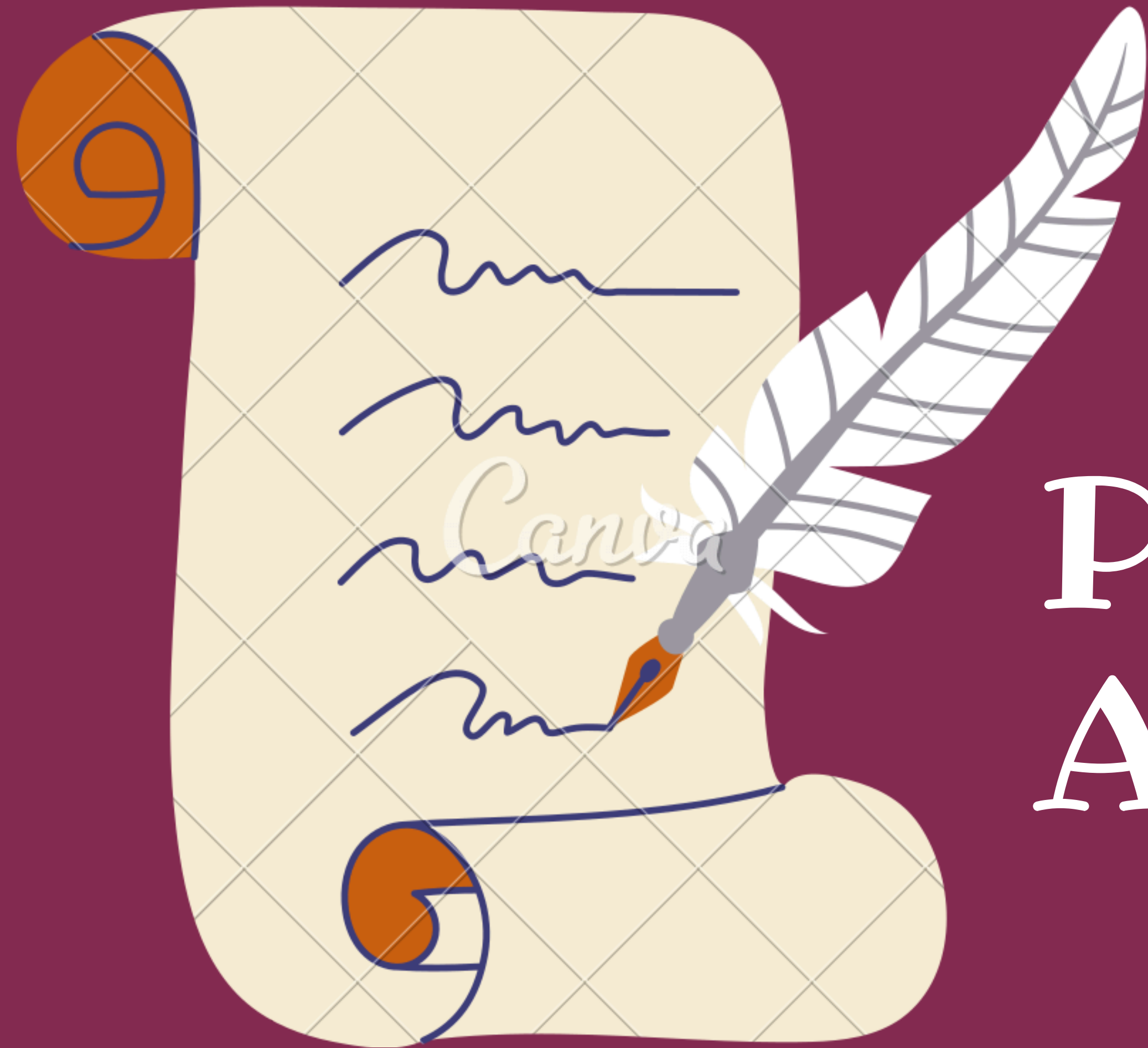

Each moment here — a thousand run.*

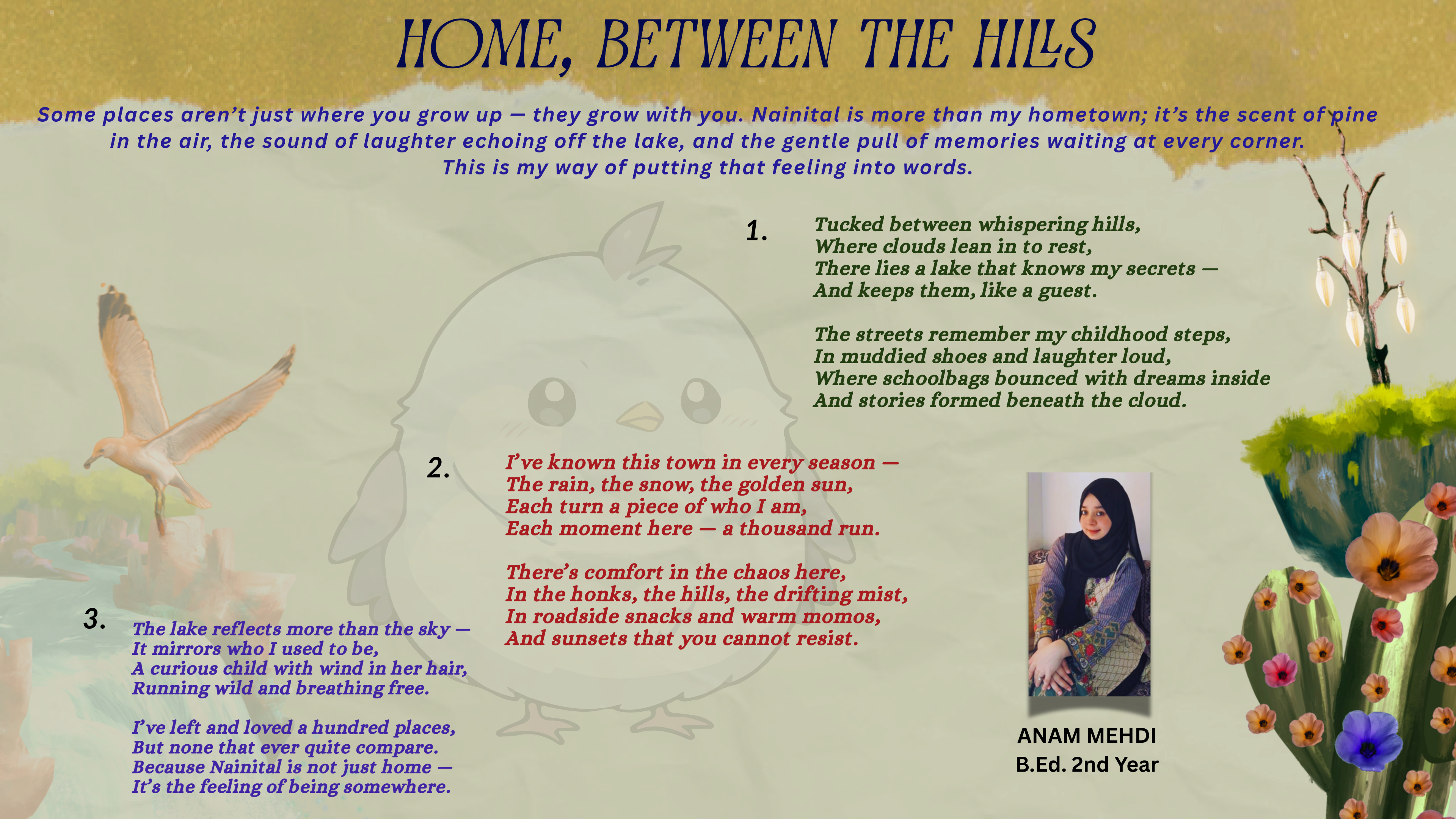
*There's comfort in the chaos here,
