Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The ICFAI University Dehradun (IUD), honoured its commitments to students in timely completion of all the academic programs offered in Business Management, Law, Education and Science and Technology. The academic year 2020-21 witnessed blended mode of conducting classes. IUD responded the evolving situation innovatively by providing technology-driven learning solutions to the academic challenges. Student-centricity was the key to conducting classes, whether in online, offline or blended mode. Campus IT infrastructure was upgraded with state of-the art audio-visual facilities to conducted the classes seamlessly.</p> <p>Online Classes: Time-tables were prepared for online classes keeping the faculty and student well-being. Consultation hours were embedded in timetable to clear doubts and support slow learners. Guest lectures were significantly increased to bring in industry perspectives in to classroom.</p> <p>Academic Tech-Infrastructure: Google Meet, Cisco Webex, Zoom, and MS Teams were used for conducting online classes, training students for placements, and other student development activities. Empowered faculty members used apps for recording attendance and monitor students online. Sessions recorded on Cloud helped students to access them at their convenience for enhancing learning. Tools such as Google Classroom, Whiteboard, Mentimeter, Google Forms, etc. were extensively used for engaging students. Study materials viz., textbooks and case studies were provided in soft copies. Students were provided unlimited access to online platforms for carrying out individual and group projects.</p> <p>Online Databases: Students as well as faculty members had access to online databases such as EBSCO, Lexis Nexis, JSTOR, Emerald etc.</p> <p>LMS Support: In-house developed LMS supported academic delivery, student monitoring and assessment. Faculty members proctored online assessments. Question banks developed were used for conducting assessments. Online control rooms set-up during assessments assisted students and faculty members to deal with technical glitches.</p> <p>Student Mentoring: Mentor-mentee interaction sessions were scheduled to address students to help them cope with the online learning environment.</p> <p>Online Assessments: Open book evaluations were adapted along with conventional assessments. A proctor was allocated for a batch of 40 students.</p> <p>Student Feedback: Online feedback collected from the students on the course delivery and performance of each faculty member was reviewed for improvements.</p> <p>Internships: Faculty and company mentored internships were held successfully for all eligible students.</p> <p>Pre-Placement Training: For the outgoing students in various faculties, online training was conducted by industry experts for making them placement ready.</p> <p>Placements: Placements continued through online and targeted placements were achieved.</p> <p>Motivation: Both the faculty members and students were motivated and timely interventions were made by the senior leadership teams for seamless transition to online environment.</p>
