Export Control

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Agreement, neither party will directly or indirectly export (or re-export) any hardware, software, technology, or technical data, or derivatives of such hardware, software, technology or technical data, or permit the shipment of same: (i) into or to a national or resident of any country subject to a United States embargo: (ii) to anyone on the U.S. Treasury Department's List of Specially Designated Narcotics Traffickers, or the U.S. Commerce Department's Denied Parties lists; or (iii) to any country or destination for which the United States government or a United States governmental agency requires an export license or other approval for export without first having obtained such license and/or other approval. Each party will reasonably cooperate with the other and will provide to the other promptly upon request any end-user certificates, affidavits regarding re-export or other certificates or documents as are reasonably requested to obtain approvals, consents, licenses, and/or permits required for any payment or any export or import of products of Services under this Agreement.
