Prof. (Dr.) Pawan K. Aggarwal, Vice Chancellor, welcomed all the members and the invitees, and presided over the meeting.

The following items were transacted:

### 6.1 Grant of Leave of absence, if any

Mr. Justice K.D. Shahi (External Member), and invitees Prof. (Dr.) Haragopal Reddy, Prof. (Dr.) A.V.N. Rao and Mr. Dhananjay Dhaundiyal could not attend the meeting and were granted Leave of absence.

## 6.2 Review of Curriculum and Syllabus of BBA. LL.B. (Hons.) Program

The board reviewed the curriculum and syllabus of BBA. LL.B. (Hons.) Program and recommended the following:

- 6.2.1 The Board examined the courses on English Language Skill-II and English Language Skill-II and recommended the following changes as per UGC guidelines:
  - ➤ English Language Skill-I and English Language Skill-II to be renamed as English Communication-I and English Communication-II respectively.
  - > Translation from English to Hindi and Hindi to English be added in the course on English Communication-I.
  - Report writing to be included in the course on English Communication-II.
- 6.2.2 Board recommended adding a course on Environmental Studies and Disaster Management in curriculum and the course on Environmental Law should remain as it is.
- 6.2.3 The Board examined the specialization in Cyber Law and Security as Honours subject and recommended the followings:
  - ➤ The Honours in Cyber Law and Security be offered along with existing Honours subjects from 2019-20.
  - > The offer of Honours subject shall be subjected to a minimum of 20 students opting for it.
- 6.2.4 The Board looked into the proposed syllabus of Spanish Language-I and Spanish Language-II under Foreign Language I and II and approved it based on the approval given by the Language expert Mr. Dhananjay Dhaundiyal who thoroughly examined the syllabi.

### 6.2.5 The Board further suggested that:

- ➤ The course under choice for Elective-II International Business Dispute Resolution Mechanism should be replaced by Gender Justice and Feministic Jurisprudence.
- > The course under choice for Elective-VI Gender Justice and Feministic Jurisprudence should be replaced by International Trade Law.

➤ The syllabus for International Trade Law to be prepared and authorized The V.C. to approve it on behalf of the board.

### 6.3 Review of curriculum and syllabus of B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) course.

The board reviewed the curriculum and syllabus of BA. LL.B. (Hons.) Program and recommended the following:

- 6.3.1 The Board examined the courses on English Language Skill-II and English Language Skill-II and recommended the following changes as per UGC guidelines:
  - English Language Skill-I and English Language Skill-II to be renamed as English Communication-I and English Communication-II respectively.
  - Translation from English to Hindi and Hindi to English be added in the course on English Communication-I.
  - Report writing to be included in the course on English Communication-II.
- 6.3.2 Board recommended adding a course on Environmental Studies and Disaster Management in curriculum and the course on Environmental Law should remain as it is.
- 6.3.3 The Board examined the specialization in Cyber Law and Security as Honours subject and recommended the followings:
  - ➤ The Honour's in Cyber Law and Security be offered along with existing Honour's subjects from 2019-20.
  - > The offer of Honour's subject shall be subjected to a minimum of 20 students opting for it.
- 6.3.4 The Board looked into the proposed syllabus of Spanish Language-I and Spanish Language-II under Foreign Language I and II and approved it based on the approval given by the Language expert Mr. Dhananjay Dhoundiyal who thoroughly examined the syllabi.

## 6.3.5 The Board further suggested that:

- ➤ The course under choice for Elective-II International Business Dispute Resolution Mechanism should be replaced by Gender Justice and Feministic Jurisprudence.
- ➤ The course under choice for Elective-VI Gender Justice and Feministic Jurisprudence should be replaced by International Trade Law.
- ➤ The syllabus for International Trade Law to be prepared and authorized The V.C. to approve it on behalf of the board.

### 6.4. Review of curriculum and syllabus of LL.B. (Three Years) course.

The Board examined the Curriculum and syllabus of LL.B (three Years Program) and recommended the following:

- ➤ The courses on Constitutional-I and Constitutional-II offered in Semester III and IV to be shifted to Semester I and Semester II respectively.
- ➤ Elective-I and Elective-II should be offered in Semester-III and Elective-III and Elective-IV should be offered in Semester-IV.
- ➤ The course under choice for Elective-II International Business Dispute Resolution Mechanism to be replaced by Gender Justice and Feministic Jurisprudence.
- > The course under choice for Elective-VI Gender Justice and Feministic Jurisprudence to be replaced by International Trade Law.
- The syllabus for International Trade Law to be prepared and authorized The V.C. to approve it on behalf of the board.
- > The course on International Law and Human Rights should be Public International Law.

## 6.5 Review of curriculum and syllabus of one year LL.M. program.

- a) The Board suggested the following modifications in the curriculum of Corporate and Commercial Law Specialization:
  - ➤ The course on International Commercial Arbitration to be renamed as National and International Commercial Arbitration Law.
  - ➤ The course on Company Law should be offered as Company Law-I and Company Law-II in Semester I and II respectively.
  - ➤ The course on Cyber Law should be deleted.
  - > The course on Intellectual Property Law should be shifted from Semester-II to Semester I.
- b) The Board suggested the following modifications in the curriculum of Constitutional and Administrative Law Specialization:
  - ➤ The course on Law of Education and Religion should be renamed as Law on Education, Religion and Minorities.
  - ➤ The course on Minority Law should be replaced by Law of Writs and Service Laws.
  - ➤ The Board suggested that the approval of syllabus of the Courses on Company Law-I, Company Law-II, Law of Writs and Service laws and Laws of Education, Religion and Minorities to framed and approved by circulation.

## Proposal to introduce the choice based credit system in the curriculum of BBA LL.B. (Hons.) and BA LL.B. (Hons.), LL.B. (Three Years) course and one year LL.M. program.

- ➤ The Choice Based Credit System is approved in principle for the curriculum of BBA LL.B (Hons), B.A LL.B (Hons), LL.B and LL.M program.
- > The curriculum and syllabus should be redesigned and remodeled as per CBCS.

## 6.7.1 Proposal for introduction of one year P.G. Diploma in Intellectual Property Law is approved with following suggestions:

- Each course should be of 60 Hours and the units should be uniformly distributed as far as possible.
- ➤ The course on Dissertation should be renamed as Dissertation/Project/Field study carrying 100 marks instead of 200 marks. Viva voice should carry 100 marks.
- > Dissertation and Viva voice should be placed in the programme structure.

### 6.8 Any other matter with the permission of the chair.

> The board suggested that the syllabus of the amended courses be approved by circulation.
