48.11 Any other item with the permission of the chair

- a. Prof S.D. Sharma, Director Kumaon University stated that the Government, vide a Gazette dated 2nd January 2021 has initiated significant changes in the Law Course. He requested the Law School to take it forward and implement the said changes by instituting a high power committee.
- b. Prof S.D. Sharma suggested that a journal, similar to many NLUs journals, be initiated by the Law School. He further added that the Editorial Board of the journal in addition to the students -should consist of senior students of the Law School.
- c. Prof Sharma was of the view that all out efforts be made to enhance the Intellectual Capital of the University, so that it is benefitted in terms of grade assessment by accrediting agencies viz. NAAC.

- d. Dr Manoj, from DIT University was of the view that at the moment emphasis should be to make the Teaching Learning more effective in order for the students to gain knowledge of the content in a better manner. The evaluation process can wait a little.
- e. Dr Manoj was of the view that the faculty should be qualified preferably with Doctorate degrees.
- f. Dr. Gita Hegde, UPES, Dehradun was of the view that the Online Examination system should be made more robust by introducing high standards, preferably the Proctored Mode.
- g. Dr. Gita Hegde also suggested that the university should now focus on attaining ranks from high quality ranking agencies.

All the above points were well taken and noted for implementation
