The ICFAI University, Dehradun entered into a MoU with Consortium of National Law Universities Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) on 10 October, 2022. The Board members noted and appreciated for MoU.

71.11 Status of Ph.D. Students:

The phase wise Ph.D. scholar's details were presented and noted. The Board members suggest to incorporate the latest UGC regulation 2022 for Ph.D. students.

71.12 Programs Promotional Activities Conducted:

The Chairperson informed that the faculty members visited the schools, coaching centres & Educational fair in collaboration with IGID marketing team for career counselling of 10th & 12th standard students for the coming session 2023.

1. Constitution of Committee for appointment of the Registrar

The term Brig. Rajiv Sethi (Retd.), Registrar will be over on April 30, 2023.

In terms of Section 17(1) of the Act read with Statute 1.4.1 and 1.4.2 of the first Statutes, the Registrar shall be appointed by the Chancellor, based on the recommendation of the Selection Committee appointed for the purpose.

The Selection Committee shall consist of the following members:

- a. One representative of the Chancellor
- b. One representative of the Sponsor who is also a member of the Board of Governors.
- c. One expert nominated by the Board of Management, who is not in any way connected with the University.

The Board of Management nominated Prof. Y. R. Haragopal Reddy on the selection committee.

The Registrar may be advised to write a letter to the Chancellor and the Sponsor requesting for the names of their representatives for constituting the Selection Committee and arrange for convening of the meeting of the Committee at the earliest.

- 3. Prof. T. S. Ramakrishna Rao suggested to incorporate a compulsory course of Environmental education for UG program according to UGC guideline.
