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



AND

Convenor, Core Committee, CLAT 2018, on behalf of the CLAT Core Committee consisting of the Vice-Chancellors/Directors of the 19 participating National Law Universities, the sole authority for regulating the examination and for declaration of the results for CLAT (Common Law Admission Test), an All India Examination administered and conducted jointly by the participating National Law Universities.

WHEREAS:

- (i) CLAT stands for Common Law Admission Test.
- (ii) ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Central Hope Town, Selaqui, Dehradun desires to utilise the CLAT 2018 Under-Graduate Examination scores for the purpose of admission during the Academic Year, 2018-19.
- (iii) Pursuant thereto ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun And the Convenor, Core Committee, CLAT, 2018 have worked out certain arrangements, as noted in this MoU with a view to utilise the CLAT 2018 UG Examination Score for the admission in ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun.
- (iv) The parties desire to record the terms and conditions and the objectives of the



University, Dehradun to interfere with the policies for the conduct of CLAT 2018, including syllabi, format, pattern of examination, etc.

- (g) It will be the sole responsibility of ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun to verify the authenticity of the information provided by the candidates applying for admission to ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun.
- (h) In case of any dispute with regard to the details of a candidate, the CLAT Office will share the details available with it, such as the address or photograph with ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun.
- (i) The Core Committee of CLAT 2018, will not interfere with the admission process of ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun.
- (j) It will be the responsibility of ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun to advertise / inform respective candidates that ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun Will be using CLAT 2018 Score for their admission purpose for the UG Programme. This information will not be included in the CLAT Brochure / Advertisement. The ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun shall pay Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) to upload the name of the Institution in the CLAT 2018 website as an Institution having a MoU with CLAT 2018.
- (k) The ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun will be required to pay an Annual Fee of Rs.1,60,000/-(Rupees One lakh and Sixty thousand only) for up to 100 seats and for more than 100 seats, Rs.1,60,000/- plus Rs. 1,000/-per extra seat to be filled excluding taxes, if applicable to the CLAT 2018. The amount shall be remitted to the "Convenor, Implementation Committee, CLAT, 2018", Kochi either by way of Bank Draft or by Electronic Transfer.
- (l) The CLAT 2018 Office will provide the above mentioned LOGIN ACCOUNT to access the details within 30 days of declaration of CLAT 2018 results, subject to payment in advance along with the MoU from ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun.

All the matters of dispute shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts in Ernakulam only. The parties shall use their best endeavours to settle any dispute or claim arising



utilization of the CLAT 2018 score incidental thereto as mutually agreed upon.

DEFINITIONS:

The following expressions used herein shall, unless repugnant to the subject or context thereof, carry the meanings here under respectively assigned to them, namely;

1. "CLAT 2018" shall mean the Common Law Admission Test conducted by the National University of Advanced Legal Studies (NUALS), Kochi, Kerala during 2018.
2. "Actual CLAT marks" shall mean the marks (Out of 200) secured by the candidates who have appeared for the CLAT 2018 Under-Graduate Examination.


NOW, THEREFORE, THIS MoU WITNESSETH as follows:

- (e) ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun Shall take prior permission from the Convenor, Core Committee, CLAT 2018, if ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI University, Dehradun desires to use the data base accessed from the LOGIN ACCOUNT for a purpose other than that stated above.
- (f) This MoU does not confer any right on the ICFAI Law School, The ICFAI






Subject: Proposal for the establishment of e-Yantra Lab Set-Up Initiative, e-Yantra Resource Development Centre and e-Yantra Nodal Centre in IDU.

About e-Yantra

- The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) sponsors E-Yantra under the National Mission for ICT in Education (NMEICT) program with the collaboration of IIT Bombay. The initiative seeks to provide hands-on learning-infrastructure to engineering students who have limited access to labs and mentors by using little robots developed by the IIT-Bombay team.
- IIT Bombay introduces the 'E-Yantra' platform to harness the intellectual talent of young India to create utility based robotic applications for usage across variety of applications such as: *agriculture, manufacturing, defense, home, city maintenance and services industries*. The overall mission is to grow a rich eco-system of ideas and applications that can propel India's growth curve and productivity through intelligent funnelling of robotics in daily living built upon an existing pool of knowledge developed by students working on such projects at engineering colleges in the area of embedded systems.

e-Yantra Lab Set Up Initiative (eLSI)

- e-Yantra Lab Setup Initiative (eLSI) is a college level program under which colleges are encouraged to setup robotics labs.
- It is designed as a scalable and sustainable approach that addresses infrastructure creation and teacher training -- to create an eco-system at the colleges to impart effective engineering education.
- eLSI provides:
 - (i) guidance and support for establishing robotics labs - three robotic kits are given to each participating college and
 - (ii) a two-phased training for teachers:
 - Two Day Workshop (Annexure)
 - Task Based Training (Annexure)

- The e-Yantra provides an intrigated platform to engineering students for the development of various applications.



- The pan-India E-Yantra challenge is open to all undergraduate students of engineering. Each group will program a given robotic platform to solve a given problem with the given resources in a 12-week duration.
- The experience will be taken to the next level through a National Robotics Competition where students from all over India will participate in theme-wise solving of tasks.
- This project presents an integrated approach for incorporating robotics into secondary and engineering education with the objective of further engaging students through an exciting application of math, computers, and science.

Preamble

In the pursuit of excellence in scholarship and dissemination of knowledge to generate reciprocal benefit within a framework of openness, fairness, and equity, that will serve both the partners, **the Icfai Business School, Icfai University, Dehradun, Uttaranchal, India, and the International University of Monaco** hereby sign a Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") for Academic Collaboration. **The Icfai Business School, Icfai University at Dehradun in India, and the International University of Monaco** in Monaco are hereinafter referred to as the "Parties".

Aim of the MoU


The aim of this MoU is to provide an umbrella for academic activities that will strengthen mutual understanding, foster friendly co-operation, and to promote sustainable and productive academic collaboration and exchange between faculty, students, and researchers of both the parties.

Scope of the MoU

Areas of joint activity may include (but are not necessarily limited to) the following:

- Joint research and training programs;
- Faculty and student exchange;
- Joint proposals for external funding;
- Joint sponsorship of conferences;
- Joint publications;
- Exchange of materials, articles and other publications; and
- Other such activities as may be mutually agreed upon.







Activities Envisaged

1. In pursuit of this aim, the Parties hereby agree to undertake to promote, within the framework of the regulations applying in each of the institutions, and subject to the availability of resources, the following activities:
 - 1-1. Research collaboration, including joint research projects in areas of mutual interest. This may also lead to the formation of Interdisciplinary Research Centers which involve inter-institutional collaboration to build a critical mass, particularly in emerging research areas;
 - 1-2. Bilateral exchanges of students for periods of one semester to twelve months duration involving joint supervision of visiting research scholars;
 - 1-3. Exchange of faculty members and research personnel. However, the number, timing and duration of such exchanges may vary according to the needs of the particular program;
 - 1-4. Exchange of academic materials like publications, databases, courseware, and sharing of library resources like research papers, indices to theses, books and magazines on relevant subjects where possible and appropriate, and other academic information;
 - 1-5. Sponsoring and conducting joint conferences, seminars, training programs, workshops and other academic meetings on matters of mutual interest.
 - 1-6. Extending invitations for attending scholarly and technical meetings and assisting in making arrangements for attending national and international conferences.

General considerations

2. The terms of, and the necessary resources for, such joint activities and exchange programs shall be discussed and mutually agreed upon in writing by both Parties through the liaison officers specified by the parties prior to the initiation of the particular activity or program. Each party should approve any funding for such activities internally. The parties may also go for external funding. The final approval of any project is subjected to the approval of both institutions and will be dependent, in part, upon the availability of guaranteed support funds.
3. It is the intention of the institutions that all research derived from the collaborative efforts of the two parties will be the joint property of both parties, proportionate to the parties' respective contributions, unless otherwise specified in an Addendum to the Memorandum of Agreement, or another writing signed by both institutions.

4. Each participant in the exchange will enjoy the same rights and privileges as the students of the host institution and will be expected to abide by the rules and regulations of the host university during the Exchange.
5. It is envisioned that the partner universities will operate, at least in targeted areas, as a single entity with flexible, permeable boundaries supporting the particular research and educational activities. This kind of activity will redefine the institutional cultures in such a way that the community of the member institutions' will view internationalization as a necessary path to excellence.
6. The signatories of this MoU will review the relationship annually. An annual Addendum will define specific activities, schedules, deliverables, and milestones and funding levels required for that year.
7. The activities under the MoU will be undertaken by an Academic Collaboration Committee consisting of a senior representative of each university, with two co-chairs, one from Icfai University's Icfai Business School, and the other from International University of Monaco .
8. This Memorandum of Understanding will commence on the date of its signing by both Parties, and shall remain in force for an initial period of three years. Any amendment of and/or modification to the MoU will require the written approval from both Parties. The MoU shall renew itself automatically for successive periods of three years unless either of the Parties notifies the other party in writing of its desire to terminate it upon six months' notice to the other party. The termination of this MoU shall not affect the implementation of the projects or programmes established under it prior to such termination.
9. This MoU does not constitute a legal or contractual obligation on the part of either party. It reflects an arrangement that is currently satisfactory to the parties involved. The parties agree to negotiate amendments to this memorandum as needed to meet the evolving requirements.



**Memorandum of Understanding

- 1 This agreement represents an initial undertaking on the part of the University of Westminster (hereafter referred to as Westminster) and ICFAI University Uttarakhand, Dehradun (hereafter referred to as ICFAI) to explore areas of potential cooperation.
- 2 Both parties undertake to nominate senior representatives whose tasks will be to explore the potential areas for cooperation.
- 3 Once areas for cooperation have been confirmed, the detailed development of the proposal(s) will be led by the relevant Dean(s) of School or nominee supported by International Partnerships and Quality and Standards within Westminster and designated colleagues within ICFAI.
- 4 Proposals that involve a Westminster award will be considered by a Westminster Validation Panel in parallel with any formal approval processes required by ICFAI. As the Awarding Institution, Westminster will be responsible for the Academic Standards and quality of the award(s).
- 5 Both parties agree to maintain full confidentiality, and observe the Intellectual Property Rights of other parties. Specific approval for any publicity must be agreed in writing prior to deployment between the appropriate parties at both institutions.
- 6 The arrangements governing any resulting collaborative provision or other type of partnership will be recorded in a formal agreement to be agreed by both institutions. Addenda to the Agreement will specify the administrative and financial arrangements of the collaborative provision or partnership.
- 7 Initially, each party undertakes to be responsible for the costs they incur during the developmental phase of the partnership. The cumulative development costs of any resulting collaborative programmes will be included in the financial arrangements for that provision.
- 8 Both parties undertake to reveal such dealings with other institutions or any material fact that may be reasonably expected to impinge on the development of this partnership.
- 9 The duration of the agreement will be for two calendar years in the first instance, to cover the period month, year to month, year.
- 10 The necessary academic and due diligence reports will be provided by both parties prior to the inception of any validation processes.



**Memorandum of Understanding

1. *The Scope of this Agreement*

Bangor University (BU) and The ICFAI University Dehradun (ICFAI) aim to establish and develop a close relationship in order to promote academic and cultural exchange between the two institutions through mutual assistance in the areas of teaching and research.

The Memorandum of Understanding will serve as a general framework for institutional co-operation. It will facilitate faculty members to discuss and develop specific programmes of co-operation. Co-operative relations shall be carried out through activities such as:

Each institution will nominate an Institutional Coordinator who will communicate regularly with his/her opposite number to monitor the progress of collaborative and staff/student exchange arrangements.


4. *Terms of the Agreement*



AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF DUNDEE, SCOTLAND AND The ICFAI UNIVERSITY, DEHRADUN, UTTARAKHAND, INDIA

REGARDING THE UNIVERSITY OF DUNDEE'S STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

Introduction

- 1) This agreement relates to the *Study Abroad Program* (referred to in the remainder of this document as the *Program*) offered by the University of Dundee and sets out the aims and the responsibilities of each university.

Aims

- 2) The *Program* offers opportunities for students to broaden their horizons and study courses in participating academic departments. It is designed to meet the needs of students who are typically sophomore (year 2) or junior (year 3) students.
- 3) This agreement sets out the responsibilities of the University of Dundee and **Icfai University, Dehradun, (IUD)** with the intention of promoting participation by international students in the University of Dundee's *Program*.

Responsibilities of both parties regarding the *Program*

- 4) Each party will:
 - a) designate an appropriately qualified and experienced member of its staff as a contact person regarding this agreement. These contact persons may be changed – in which case the other party should be advised in advance, with the new contact details.
 - b) seek to promote participation by students in the *Program*.
 - c) provide information to the other associated with the effective operation of, and participation by, **IUD** students in the *Program*

Responsibilities of University of Dundee regarding the *Program*

- 5) The University of Dundee will be responsible for:
 - a) provision of the *Program*

- b) assurance of academic standards and quality of the *Program* in accordance with the University's academic policies and procedures and in reference to the relevant policies of the UK Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education.
 - c) provision of information describing the content and academic standards of the *Program* and competent courses
 - d) provision of information describing the University, the fees, and the support and entitlements that the university will provide to students participating in the *Program*
 - e) credit-rating the academic standards of the *Program* with reference to the Scottish Credit & Qualifications Framework
 - f) providing a transcript of achievement to all students who participate in the *Program* and a certified copy to **Icfai University, Dehradun (IUD)**.
 - g) monitoring and evaluating the standards and quality of student experience on the *Program* and preparing an annual report. A copy of this report will be sent to **Icfai University, Dehradun (IUD)**
 - h) advising **Icfai University, Dehradun, (IUD)** of any developments or significant issues that could affect participation by students on the *Program*
- 6) The University of Dundee will treat students admitted to the *Program* as full members of the university community, and wherever possible they will be fully integrated in terms of teaching and accommodation. These students will be granted the same rights and access to facilities and services as other international undergraduate students
- 7) All students participating in the *Program* will be guaranteed an offer of a place in University of Dundee student accommodation.

Responsibilities of Icfai University, Dehradun, (IUD) regarding the *Program*

- 8) **Icfai University, Dehradun, (IUD)** will be responsible for:
- a) liaison with the designated contact at the University of Dundee
 - b) making information on the *Program* available to students
 - c) providing support and advice to students considering applying for the *Program*. This should include referring any specific issues or questions to the University of Dundee contact
 - d) advising the University of Dundee of any developments or significant issues that would affect participation by students

Financial arrangements

- 9) The University of Dundee will provide clear information regarding costs and entitlements associated with the *Program*.

- 10) Neither party shall have the authority to authorise expenditure or incur liability on behalf of the other party.


Publicity and information about the collaboration

- 11) Both parties may make reference in publicity to this agreement and the related activities provided that the references relate only to the *Program* and/or exploration of potential for the future, wider collaboration. They must not make reference to any other academic standards or services.

Arrangements for termination of this Agreement



STUDY ABROAD AGREEMENT

Between

the University of Essex
Wivenhoe Park, Colchester, Essex CO4 3SQ, United Kingdom

AND

FedUni (Federation of Universities), a Federation of all ICFAI Universities,
Plot No.54, Nagarjuna Hills, Hyderabad 500 082, India

- 1) The Federation of Universities (hereinafter called "FedUni" consisting of IFHE Hyderabad; ICFAI University Dehradun; ICFAI University Jharkhand; ICFAI University Tripura, ICFAI University Sikkim, ICFAI University Nagaland, ICFAI University Meghalaya and ICFAI University Mizoram), intends to continue and expand its commitment to Study Abroad and to increase the number of its undergraduate Study Abroad programmes by entering into an agreement with the University of Essex (hereinafter referred to as "Essex") for direct enrolment of selected undergraduates into the University of Essex Study Abroad Programme. This agreement is intended to further that objective.
- 2) The FedUni will:
 - a) Select students as suitable for admission by the Essex to its Study Abroad Programme. An average grade of 50% will normally be required for admission to the programme, but where extenuating circumstances apply, a lower average may be considered.
 - b) Prepare Application Forms with academic recommendations and a transcript and send them to Essex at the appropriate time, ideally by 1 May

for admission in the following October and by the end of October for admission in the following January. This will enable students' preliminary course choices to be checked and discussed within Essex and with the students as necessary. Later applications can be considered by Essex, but there will be no guarantee of on-campus accommodation for applications received after 1 May for admission the following October or after 1 November for admission the following January.


- c) Be responsible, on receipt of the final costs from the University of Essex, for making payment to the Essex of tuition fees. Tuition fees and all other costs will be payable in pounds sterling. Students will be responsible for their own accommodation fees and other expenses including food as the University of Essex does not offer a meal plan.


3) Essex will:

- a) Admit suitably qualified ICFAI Universities students to the Study Abroad Programme for an academic year; Autumn Term, or Spring & Summer terms. FedUni will normally be notified of the admission decision immediately upon receipt of completed application documents. Documentation for students who have accepted offers of admission to Essex will include formal letters of admission or a CAS to meet immigration requirements on arrival in the United Kingdom.
- b) Offer an integrated Study Abroad experience:
 - 1) academically, with students taking regular undergraduate courses and suitable assessment, and
 - 2) socially, by dispersing ICFAI Universities students among University of Essex degree students in the on-campus residences.

- c) Guarantee University-owned, single occupancy study-bedroom accommodation, normally on-campus, in self-catering accommodation to all accepted students for whom application materials have been received by the agreed upon deadlines.
 - d) Enrol ICFAI Universities students as full students of the University of Essex with regular access to all support services including medical services, counselling, library and computing services, orientation, academic advising and to all recreational facilities.
 - e) Provide a transcript showing credits and grades obtained at the end of the course for each student.
 - f) Provide discounted fees for ICFAI Universities students of 90% of the standard fee for the Study Abroad Programme at Essex if there are five or more students from ICFAI Universities attending Essex in a given year.
- 4) This agreement will be effective until either institution wishes to terminate it. A period of 12 months' notice will be required before termination can take effect.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

(University of Salford M5 4WT, UK)

And

FedUni (Federation of Universities), a Federation of all ICFAI Universities,
Plot No.54, Nagarjuna Hills, Hyderabad 500 082, India

In order to promote co-operation between the *Federation of Universities* (hereinafter called "FedUni" consisting of IFHE Hyderabad; ICFAI University Dehradun; ICFAI University Jharkhand; ICFAI University Tripura, ICFAI University Sikkim, ICFAI University Nagaland, ICFAI University Meghalaya and ICFAI University Mizoram) the *University of Salford, UK*, the two institutions (also referred to as the Parties) agree as follows:

Both institutions will encourage direct contact and co-operation between their Faculty and administrative staff, including those of relevant internal Schools and the Universities' Research Institutes.

Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of co-operation will be pursued:

- Joint research activities
- Development activities in the delivery of the University of Salford programmes
- Joint teaching and the development of new degree and training programmes
- Visits by and exchange of staff and graduate students for research, teaching and discussions
- Exchange of information including, but not limited to, and where possible (taking into consideration pre-existing rights, contracts and confidentiality agreements) exchange of library materials and research publications
- Development of student progression pathways

Specific details for the implementation of these activities will be developed mutually on a "project by project" basis.

Both Parties understand that all financial, project details and legal arrangements and terms and conditions will have to be negotiated on fair and reasonable terms and will depend on the availability of funds. Any formal activity shall be set up under required contractual and financial regulation procedures of the Universities and requirements of funding organisations as and when these become relevant.

Neither FedUni nor the University of Salford intends to create any contract by virtue of this memorandum of understanding and an agreement for each joint activity, collaboration or project will only become legally binding once it has been negotiated and is contained in a detailed written contract which has been signed by duly authorised signatories of both parties.


Although this is not a legally binding agreement, for the avoidance of doubt, if there is no communication between the parties under this memorandum of understanding for a period of 3 consecutive years, then this memorandum of understanding will automatically end on the expiry of that period. This memorandum of understanding will also end either: (a) with the written consent of both parties; or (b) by one party giving to the other party of at least 9 months' written notice to that effect. To be clear, the ending of this memorandum of understanding will not prejudice or affect the validity of any contract entered into by the parties under this memorandum of understanding. After that review, this memorandum of understanding will continue for such further period as the parties may decide in writing.
